### Maintenance Medications – 90-day Supply

### Classic and Saver HSA options

1. What is the 90-day supply requirement?

It's a feature of your prescription plan managed by Express Scripts. With it, you have two ways to get up to a three-month supply of your long-term medications (those drugs you take regularly for ongoing conditions). You can conveniently fill those prescriptions either through home delivery from the Express Scripts Pharmacy or from any Walgreens or Duane Reade pharmacy.

2. What is Smart90 Walgreens?

Smart90 Walgreens is the name of the program developed between Walgreens and Express Scripts that allows members to receive a 90-day supply of medications through retail at Walgreens locations.

3. How many Walgreens pharmacies are available to me?

There are more than 9,800 Walgreens pharmacies. All Walgreens and affiliates participate in Smart90. To locate one, visit [express-scripts.com](http://express-scripts.com) and click "Prescriptions," then "Find a Pharmacy"; participating pharmacies will be noted in your search results. Members may also call Express Scripts at 1-877-207-1357.

4. What happens if I keep filling my long-term medication like I'm doing now?

Per your plan, if you keep filling a 30-day supply instead of utilizing one of the Plan's 90-day supply options to fill your long-term medication, you'll pay the full cost for your medication. This amount will not apply to your deductible or out-of-pocket amounts.

5. What does "full cost" mean?

"Full cost" is the actual cost of your medication. For example, the actual cost of the medication might be \$75, but if you have a copayment or coinsurance, your payment might only be \$20. "Full cost" means that your payment would be the entire \$75.

6. What is the advantage of getting up to a 90-day supply vs. a 30-day supply?

By getting up to a 90-day supply, you'll make fewer trips to the pharmacy, and you'll only need to make one payment every three months. Also, there's usually a savings for getting 90-day supply vs. three 30-day supplies at retail. After either the second time you purchase a 30-day supply of a long-term drug at a network pharmacy, you will pay the entire cost.

But you can avoid paying more by choosing a 90-day option — either through home delivery from the Express Scripts Pharmacy or from a Walgreens pharmacy. You will pay the same copayment for your 90-day supply whether you fill through home delivery from the Express Scripts Pharmacy or from a Walgreens pharmacy.

7. How do I get a 90-day supply of my medication?

You can have the Express Scripts Pharmacy deliver it (with FREE standard shipping) by visiting [express-scripts.com/90day](http://express-scripts.com/90day). You can also fill your prescription at a Walgreens pharmacy.



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8. What is the difference between long-term and short-term drugs?

Long-term drugs, also called maintenance medications, are those you take on an ongoing basis, such as to treat high blood pressure or high cholesterol. Short-term drugs include antibiotics and other medications that you take for short periods of time. Under your plan, you can fill short-term prescriptions at any participating retail pharmacy in your network.

9. I already use home delivery from the Express Scripts Pharmacy to get my long-term drugs. Do I need to change anything?

No. If you're using home delivery services from the Express Scripts Pharmacy for your long-term drugs, you may already be saving money under your plan. Congratulations! You don't need to do a thing.

### Other Important Details

#### Changing Prescriptions to Home Delivery or Smart90

- a. Members are responsible for working with their treating physician to transfer medications to Home Delivery or Smart90. The prescription (i.e., dosage or quantity) will not be filled more than permitted.
- b. Members are responsible for obtaining a new prescription to be used for home delivery. If switching from Home Delivery to Smart90, the member is responsible for cancelling their Home Delivery script.
- c. Members can log in to their online account and select medications that they would like to transfer to Home Delivery. Express Scripts will contact the prescribers to request the 90-day prescription. You may need to notify your prescriber; some providers will ignore the request if the patient does not contact them.
- d. Walgreens has been very helpful in assisting members with getting their prescriptions transferred to them and set-up as 90-day supplies as well.
- e. Members do not need to take any action if they wish to continue receiving medications through Home Delivery.

#### Pricing

- a. Members are required to meet the individual or family retail deductible when using Smart90.
- b. Members have the ability can price medications for Smart90, Home Delivery and retail through their Express Scripts account.
- c. Medication costs and drug lists (i.e., brand formulary and non-formulary and generic) are the same for Home Delivery, Smart90 and retail.
- d. Members will NOT be able to use a manufacturer coupon with Smart90 like they do with retail 30-day supply. This is consistent with Home Delivery
